The school is divided into three (3) areas of studies:

### **1. Leadership and Helps Ministry**

## ***GENERAL STUDENTS INFORMATION***

### ***Admission Requirements***

All students must:

1. Be at least 18 years old
2. Be born again and living a biblically clean, committed life.
3. Be committed to the absolute Lordship and Leadership of Jesus Christ through an ongoing personal relationship with Him, and have a desire to reach greater maturity in Him, in full obedience to His will
4. Submit a completed application form along with the Life Assessment fee of \$100.00 (This fee is non-refundable)
5. Furnish a current photograph with your completed application form (Head and shoulder photograph only) ***Photo will not be returned.***
6. Be notified, in writing, of acceptance

### ***Discrimination Policy***

Faith Bible Institute does not discriminate against or deny the benefits of any program or activity at the School on the basis of race, color or ethnic origin.

### ***Days, Hours, and length of Classes***

Each quarter is eight (8) weeks in length.

Registration is at the beginning of each quarter.

***Campus Policy***

***Eating and Drinking***

There will be no eating or drinking in class, however water is permitted.

***Tardiness***

Students are Expected to be on time for classes. Late reporting two times will constitute one absence. Students must notify a member of the administration team and or instructor by phone or text message that they will be arriving late to class.

***Attendance***

Students must notify a member of the administration team and/ or instructor by phone, text message, or email that they will be absent from class. If the expected absence is not communicated, the absent will be considered unexcused. Any student absent from two classes must withdraw as a campus student an finished the course online. The difference in tuition should be paid at that time.

***Inclement Weather***

In the event of inclement weather and for the safety of our staff and students, school may be closed. We will keep you informed of weather condition and advised according.

## **Distractions**

Alarm watches, cell phones, beepers, headphones, etc., can be very disturbing. Do not use any of these items in class. If you must use them, put them on vibrate. We also request that student refrain from activities such as text messages, emailing, participating in chat line conversations, surfing the Internet, social media, Facebook, tapping pencil's/pens, putting feet on chairs, chewing gum, and engaging in non-relative class conversation during the class.

## **Grading System**

## **Examinations**

Students are expected to take examinations at scheduled times. Late students' examinations will be administered only to students who are absent because of illness or emergencies. Examinations are to be made up by that following Saturday. Failure to attend a make-up test will automatically result in a failing grade for the test.

A Late Fee of \$15.00 will be applied for late examinations. The late fee must be paid prior to taking the examination.

## **General Student Guidelines and Regulations:**

Change in address, telephone number, name, email address. etc., should be reported immediately to Faith Bible Institute by completing the Name-Address Change form.

## **Students with Special Needs**

If you have special needs, please advise a member of the Faith Bible Institute Administrative Staff in writing.

## **Withdrawal Policy**

Faith Bible Institute takes withdrawals very seriously. Telephone cancellation or verbal agreement with instructors will not constitute an official withdrawal. Students must submit an official withdrawal in writing.

## **Withdrawal Deadlines**

On-line and correspondence students – The last day to withdraw academic penalty is within one week after receiving the course syllabus.

## **Unauthorized**

A student who leaves during a quarter without officially withdrawing will be administratively withdrawn. A grade of I (incomplete) shall be placed on the student's academic transcript for courses enrolled in that quarter, unless the dean specifies that WF (withdraw failing) be posted.

## **Drop / Add Policy**

1. A student may drop a class and enroll in another no later than the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of each quarter.
2. All fees and tuition must be paid prior to or at the time of dropping the class.

## **Repeating a Course**

A student who receives a grade of “D” in a required course must repeat the course in order to graduate. A student may also elect to repeat any other course in order to improve the grade assigned for that course. When a course is repeated, the last grade points and credit hours earned will replace the previous grade point average. However, all grade entries on the transcript remain a part of the student's permanent academic record.



## Refund Policy

1. The refund policy is designed to be fair to both student and the Institute.
  - Refunds are granted on a quarterly basis in accordance with the tuition payment plan
  - Student fees, application fee, and cost of books will not be refunded
  
2. Tuition that has been paid by another party, such as a friend or a relative (including parties who remain anonymous to the student), will be refunded to the paying party unless otherwise stated.
  
3. Refund Guidelines:
  - Prior to the start of class: 100% of tuition
  - During the first week of class: 80% of Tuition
  - During the second week of class: 50% of Tuition
  - After the second week of class: *NO REFUND*

## **Graduation Requirements:**

***It is the student's responsibility to notify the Faith Bible Institute Administration Department of your upcoming requirements for Graduation.***

1. A cumulative grade point of a C must be maintained. Any student with a grade point of a C who has failed to complete a class, must make up the class prior to receiving a diploma.
2. Evidence of true Christian character must be demonstrated during the school year.
3. All financial responsibilities to the school must be met.
4. All requirements for Christian service must be satisfied.
5. The required amount of credits to receive a degree must be acknowledged by Faith Bible Institute and Faith Bible College.
6. Graduation ceremony will be held in Independence, MO in May of each year. However, a student may elect to forgo the graduation ceremony.
7. Students with enough credits may receive a degree without participating in the graduation ceremony. The required form must be completed electing your choice not to attend. Your degree will be received in May. Please notified The Faith Bible Institute Administration Department approximately (8 -12) weeks prior to graduation.

### **Conduct**

1. Student shall not divulge or discuss issues relative to Faith Bible Institute with members of the general congregation or anyone outside of Faith Bible Institute.
2. Students must willfully submit to the leadership of Faith Bible Institute /or any rules, policies, or procedures that may be changed from time to time.
3. Students will at all times conduct themselves in a respectable manner when interacting with one another, instructors and staff.

## **Pastoral Review**

It is important that each student's pastor be involved during the course of The Faith Bible Institute school year and that Faith Bible Institute leadership stays in communication with each pastor.

The pastoral review accomplishes this, and is, therefore, an important document that must be processed in a timely manner.

1. Each student is required to give the Pastoral Review to his/her pastor to be filled out and email back to the school **rtaylor@thefaithbibleinstitute.com**

(These reviews will be handed out twice during the school year.)

2. The Chancellor / Dean must receive the Pastoral Review within two weeks of the day that it was handed out. (It is the student's responsibility to communicate this to his/her pastor.)

3. A student **will not** be allowed to continue attending Faith Bible Institute if the Pastoral Review is not received.

## *2020 - 2021 Description of Courses*

### *Believers Integrity, Honor and Excellence*

This course is a study of integrity, honor, and excellence in the various aspects of ministry and private life. This course explores the sources, methods, disputes, and insights of Christian ethics. Importance of integrity in the believer's life. Importance of ethics and excellence in the believer and ministry, including excerpts from the Old and New Testament.

### *The Nature of God*

This course will help you understand the heart of God. God is Love. "For God so Loved the world, that He Gave."

In this course, students will gain a deeper knowledge and understanding of the Nature of God's Unconditional Love. The apostle John wrote in 1 John 3:1, "Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God!" God wants a family of sons and daughters of His own kind. He wants a family of love that expresses His true nature. For God is love.

### *Spiritual Discernment*

This course is an introduction to the art of spiritual discernment, which will enable students to recognize and respond to the prompting or inner witness of the Spirit. The course will provide a model for effective decision-making that will incorporate the wisdom of the Christian heritage. The primary focus will be upon seeking the wisdom and direction of God for critical choices and decisions.

### *Women of the Bible*

This course will examine the women of the bible who were outstanding in their faith. Like the woman with the issue of blood and others.

### ***Praise and Worship***

This course will help you to learn how to Worship God In Spirit And In Truth. It will teach us how to praise and worship God in the way acceptable to Him. Jesus says in John 4:24, “*God is a spirit and they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth.*” This course will teach us how to enter the presence of the Lord.

### ***Jewishness of Jesus***

This course will give you a comprehensive teaching on the Jewishness of Jesus. It will help you understand the customs Life and times surrounding Jesus, the Messiah and how He lived out the Old Testament. This study also looks at the Biblical Feasts and gives a symbolic view of Messiah.

### ***The Book of Revelation***

This course is design to give you an in-depth study of the book of final things, including things seen, that are, and that shall be hereafter.

This course will take the student through the entire book with cross references to other portions of Scripture. The purpose is to assist the student in gaining a greater comprehension of the biblical teaching contained in the Book of Revelation with an emphasis on practical application.

### **Preparation for Ministry**

This course will teach you the practical side of a minister’s life and duties. It will include instruction in the proper manner of services, and a discussion of many of the problems a pastor faces. This course will give you a practical ministry activity that will enhance the overall effective ministry of the local church. It will also prepare you for the ministry of helps.



## ***The Faith Bible Institute Alumni Association***

The objectives of The Faith Bible Institute Alumni Association, under Faith Bible College, are to unite the graduates who wish to associate themselves for charitable, educational and literal purposes, and to promote the general welfare of the Faith Bible Institute Alumni Association.
