Admission Requirements

All students must:

1. Be at least 18 years old
2. Be born again and living a biblically clean, committed life.
3. Be committed to the absolute Lordship and Leadership of Jesus Christ through an ongoing personal relationship with Him, and have a desire to reach greater maturity in Him, in full obedience to His will
4. Submit a completed application form along with the Life Assessment fee of \$100.00 (This fee is non-refundable)
5. Furnish a current photograph with your completed application form (Head and shoulder photograph only) ***Photo will not be returned.***
6. Be notified, in writing, of acceptance

Examinations

Students are expected to take examinations at scheduled times. Late students' examinations will be administered only to students who are absent because of illness or emergencies. Examinations are to be made up by that following Saturday. Failure to take a make-up test will automatically result in a failing grade for the test.

A Late Fee of \$15.00 will be applied for late examinations. The late fee must be paid prior to taking the examination.

General Student Guidelines and Regulations:

Students with Special Needs

Withdrawal Policy

Faith Bible Institute takes withdrawals very seriously. Telephone cancellation or verbal agreement with instructors will not constitute an official withdrawal. Students must submit an official withdrawal in writing.

Withdrawal Deadlines

Virtual students – The last day to withdraw academic penalty is within one week after receiving the course syllabus.

Unauthorized

A student who leaves during a quarter without officially withdrawing will be administratively withdrawn. A grade of I (incomplete) shall be placed on the student's academic transcript for courses enrolled in that quarter, unless the dean specifies that WF (withdraw failing) be posted.

Drop / Add Policy

1. A student may drop a class and enroll in another no later than the 2nd week of each quarter.
2. All fees and tuition must be paid prior to or at the time of dropping the class.

Repeating a Course

A student who receives a grade of "D" in a required course must repeat the course to graduate. A student may also elect to repeat any other course to improve the grade assigned for that course. When a course is repeated, the last grade points and credit hours earned will replace the previous grade point average. However, all grade entries on the transcript remain a part of the student's permanent academic record.

Refund Policy

1. The refund policy is designed to be fair to both student and the Institute.
 - Refunds are granted on a quarterly basis in accordance with the tuition payment plan
 - Student fees, application fee, and cost of books will not be refunded

2. Tuition that has been paid by another party, such as a friend or a relative (including parties who remain anonymous to the student), will be refunded to the paying party unless otherwise stated.

3. Refund Guidelines:
 - Prior to the start of class: 100% of tuition
 - During the first week of class: 80% of Tuition
 - During the second week of class: 50% of Tuition
 - After the second week of class: *NO REFUND*

Graduation Requirements:

It is the student's responsibility to notify the Faith Bible Institute Administration Department of your upcoming requirements for Graduation.

1. A cumulative grade point of a C must be maintained. Any student with a grade point of a C who has failed to complete a class, must make up the class prior to receiving a diploma.
2. Evidence of true Christian character must be demonstrated during the school year.
3. All financial responsibilities to the school must be met.
4. All requirements for Christian service must be satisfied.
5. The required number of credits to receive a degree must be acknowledged by Faith Bible Institute and Faith Bible College.
6. Graduation ceremony will be held in Independence, MO in May of each year. However, a student may elect to forgo the graduation ceremony.
7. Students with enough credits may receive a degree without participating in the graduation ceremony. The required form must be completed electing your choice not to attend. Your degree will be received in May. Please notified The Faith Bible Institute Administration Department approximately (8 -12) weeks prior to graduation.

2. The Chancellor / Dean must receive the Pastoral Review within two weeks of the day that it was handed out. (It is the student's responsibility to communicate this to his/her pastor.)

3. A student **will not** be allowed to continue attending Faith Bible Institute if the Pastoral Review is not received.

Course Descriptions

Bible Doctrine

This course will give you a comprehensive understanding of the fundamental doctrines of the Bible. Basic Christian Doctrine is the study of the revealed word of God. It is Christian Theology regarding the nature, truth, God, Jesus, salvation, damnation, the Trinity, the Holy Spirit, the Gospel, resurrection, and more.

Ethics

This course will give you the principles derived from the Christian faith according to scripture to live a godly life. It is a study of Christian Ethics, integrity, honor, and excellence in the various aspects of ministry and private life including excerpts from the Old and New Testament.

By using these principles, we find in Scripture, Christians can determine the ethical course for any given situation.

Israel History – Part 1

In this course you will receive an overview of the historical background of the Hebrew Bible/Old Testament. The focus is on the history of the land and the people of ancient Israel.

This course covers the 800-year span of Israel's history as a nation as documented in Joshua, Judges, 1 and 2 Samuel, and 1 and 2 Kings. It progresses through the conquest of the Canaan (or the Promised Land) under Joshua to the period of the Judges, the united monarchy under Saul, David and Solomon, through the divided monarchies of Israel and Judah, and finally, the fall of both nations.

The Life of Moses

This **course** provides the student with an in-depth study on the life of Moses. Moses is one of the most prominent figures in the Old Testament. While Abraham is called the “Father of the Faithful” and the recipient of God’s unconditional covenant of grace to His people, Moses was the man chosen to bring redemption to His people.

Marriage and Family

This course is designed to help you understand that marriage is difficult for any couple to sustain over a lifetime. Life’s trials—the pressure of making a living, of parenting, of resisting temptations to unfaithfulness or selfishness—can strain any marriage.

But Christian marriage offers hope. The hope that a husband and wife, by intentionally choosing to learn how to love faithfully and sacrificially as Jesus did, may keep their covenant promises for a lifetime. In this class you will learn that marriage is a covenant, a relationship based on promises and commitment, not just feelings—though love is most certainly involved.

Christian Obedience to God

This course is designed to help you understand the heart of God through obedience to His Word and His Will and His commandments.

Christian obedience is the act of submitting (obeying) to the commands (laws) of God, the highest authority, creator, and Father of mankind. If you have faith in God then obedience is the practice of living by faith, obeying the teachings of the Word of God.

The Pentateuch

In this course, you will learn the first five books of the Bible, also known as the Torah, which is the first five books of the Hebrew Bible (Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, and Deuteronomy). Traditionally ascribed to Moses,

The Pentateuch or Torah contains God's law and His dealings with humankind from the creation of the world to the death of Moses. It combines poetry, prose, and law in a chronological drama spanning thousands of years.

Basic Counseling Skills Part 1

This course will introduction you to the essential skills needed for effective Christian counseling. Students will spend a significant amount of time practicing basic counseling skills through role playing and real-life interactions with critical review by both peers and the instructor.

It will include fundamental vocabulary and skills used in Christian Counseling. This course will also give background knowledge to some of the theories in individual, couples, and family counseling.

The Faith Bible Institute Alumni Association
